
A Must-Have California Native Plant!

Pink Honeysuckle

Lonicera hispidula





Light: Full Sun / Part to Full Shade



30 species of butterflies and moths can lay eggs on this plant.



Sphinx moth is often mistaken for a hummingbird, as they are nearly the same size. Its large caterpillar provides a significant meal for hungry baby birds.

Keystone Plant: This California native is a "must have" (host) plant for caterpillars, which, in turn, are the "must have" food for baby birds.


