# Dutchman's Pipevine

*Aristolochia californica*



**Description:** Dutchman's Pipevine is a deciduous vine with one inch purple striped pipe-shaped flowers and large, heart-shaped leaves. Its lush green foliage is the only food for the pipevine swallowtail caterpillars.



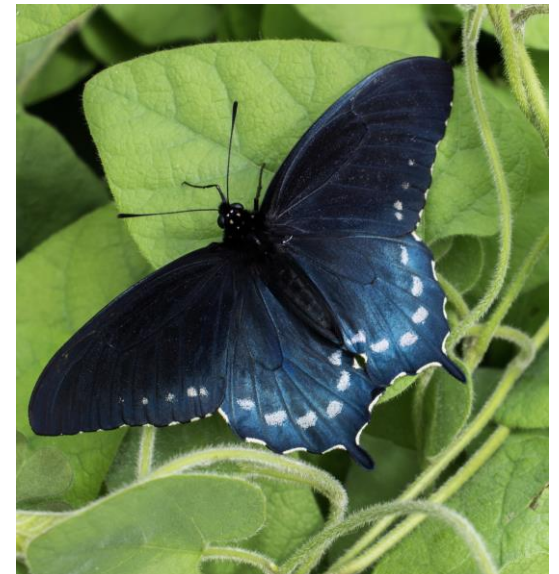
**Light:** Part Shade



**A Must-Have Plant:** Dutchman's pipevine is the only plant the exquisite pipevine swallowtail butterfly can lay its eggs on. Plant this in a shaded, moist area, and the pipevine swallowtail butterflies will come!



**Featured Butterfly:** The large, beautiful *Pipevine Swallowtail* butterfly can be seen in the garden during the spring and summer, nectaring on verbena, sage, blue dicks, lupine and buckeye tree blossoms.
